

On Mon., April 22, Equinox was honored to accept a check in the amount of \$15,000 for its Domestic Violence Services from the **Phil with Love Foundation**—a foundation started by the Rabadi family in memory of their son/brother, Phillip, who was a surgical PA at St. Peter’s Health Partners and was tragically killed two years ago. The Foundation was established to carry on Phillip’s legacy of helping others.

Equinox is one of four local charities that has been chosen by the Rabadi family be the first recipients of proceeds raised by the Foundation through their Annual Golf Tournament hosted last summer.
