- 16 to 21 years of age
- Currently free of alcohol or drug addiction
- Have no recent history of violent behavior

- Seek and find employment
- Complete your high school education, GED Program, or vocational training
- Get your life on track
- Learn the skills needed to live independently in the community

- No appointment needed
- To simplify assessment process, arrive with application completed
- Application can be emailed or faxed to you in advance

- Case management services
- Guidance in developing independent living skills
- Referrals to counseling agencies and other community resources
- Individualized life plan
- Career and employment assistance
- Educational support
- Access to medical and dental care
- Follow-up assistance after discharge from program
